RICHARD “DICK” ROCHFORD EARNS NAFI MASTER INSTRUCTOR ACCREDITATION

The National Association of Flight Instructors is proud to announce that NAFI member Dick Rochfort has earned accreditation as a NAFI Master Flight Instructor. This is Rochfort’s eighth consecutive NAFI Master Instructor accreditation.

Rochfort is an Airline Transport Pilot and Master Instructor providing training, consulting, aircraft relocation and expert witness services worldwide to owners, pilots and instructors of the Piper PA-46 aircraft through his company, RWR Pilot Training and The Professional Association of Pilot Instructors (PAPI) of which he is a founding member.



He holds ATP, Commercial and Gold Seal Flight Instructor Certificates with SEL, SES, MEL, CFII, MEI, and CE-525S ratings. He has been actively involved in flight training as an instructor since 1992.

Rochfort has researched, written and published hundreds of articles and demonstration videos specific to the operation of Piper PA-46 aircraft. This body of work comprises the PA46 Pilot Reference Library, which is the single largest on-line collection of its kind. Additionally, he creates and manages more than 6,500 personal training videos and documents on over 100 private on-line reference libraries each year for his training customers.

Rochfort’s training programs are PA-46 type-specific, insurance industry approved, FAA Industry Training Standards (FITS) approved, FAA Wings approved and they are fully insured.

Rochfort is an FAA FAAS Team volunteer for the Baltimore FSDO, a National Industry Member of the FAA Safety Team, a member of the national FAA Wings Industry Advisory Committee, Director Emeritus of the Malibu Mirage Owners and Pilots Association (M/MOPA), and Instructor Emeritus of the M/MOPA Safety and Training Foundation. He is a member of EAA and NBAA. He is also the Official Meridian Instructor for Red Bull Air Racer Kirby Chambliss and Team Chambliss.

Rochfort served as a “Green Beret” staff sergeant E6 in the U.S. Army Special Forces from 1970 until 1976 as an “A team” radio operator, training indigenous personnel in field radio communications. He worked from 1976 until 1991 as an industrial engineer training manufacturing personnel for the production of communication and navigation equipment for the U.S. military.

His education includes undergraduate degrees in clinical psychology and engineering, and a master’s degree in business administration. Rochfort lives in Baltimore, Maryland with his wife and has two daughters. He is a PADI (Professional Association of Diving Instructors) certified open water scuba instructor, a DAN (Divers Alert Network) certified first aid instructor and an Eagle Scout.

*The **NAFI Master Flight Instructor Accreditation** is earned by aviation educators based upon a system of advanced professional standards and peer review. The accreditation identifies and publicly recognizes those teachers of flight who demonstrate an ongoing commitment to excellence, professional growth, and service to the aviation community. The NAFI Master Instructor accreditation is for two years and may be used to renew an FAA flight instructor certificate. Applicants must have been a CFI for two years and have given 1,000 hours of flight instruction. In addition, candidates must meet and document activity in four NAFI Master Instructor categories (Instructor, Educator, Service to the Aviation Community, and Professional Activity).*

*Members of the **National Association of Flight Instructors** work as independent instructors, at flight schools, universities, FBOs, corporate flight departments and in the military. Since 1967, NAFI and its members, who teach in 30 countries, are dedicated to increasing and maintaining the professionalism of flight instruction.
