“How Type Clubs Benefit Flight Instructors”

Instructors become quite good at teaching the skills needed to succeed on FAA Practical Tests flying the airplanes in their training fleet. However, when providing Flight Reviews, IPC and transition training in other aircraft types, there are often changes in technique required to accomplish tasks and maneuvers driven by the specific characteristics of the airplane flown. That includes critical safety procedures and information that accompany the unique systems of that airplane's design. A good recurrent session becomes great by including type-specific training; it's vital when providing transition training to present the airplane's unique procedures and techniques.

How do you get the type-specific knowledge you need to provide this critical training? Aircraft Type Clubs have resources for flight instructors for the makes they represent. This program will explore the resources available to you through Type Clubs, often free to instructors.
